Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of our clients, Kimberly School District #414 and Wendell School District #232 (collectively, the "Districts"). On January 7, 2025, the Districts received notification from their thirdparty vendor, PowerSchool, regarding a cybersecurity incident that impacted their data maintained in PowerSchool. PowerSchool provides Student Information Systems to the Districts, which is used to manage education information related to students and staff. Upon learning about this incident, the Districts immediately began an investigation with the assistance of legal counsel and a nationally recognized cyber security and digital forensics firm. On January 17, 2025, the cyber security firm working with the Districts' staffs confirmed that the data affected by the PowerSchool incident included personal information as defined in Idaho Code § 28-51-104(5). The personal information affected included Idaho residents' names and Social Security numbers. Therefore, the Districts are reporting a breach of the security of the system, pursuant to Idaho Code § 28-51-105(1), resulting from the cybersecurity incident impacting PowerSchool.

The Districts will continue to investigate and will ensure that proper written notice is provided to the impacted individuals, as required by law, together with an offer of complimentary credit monitoring where appropriate. We will keep you informed of any significant developments as the investigation continues.
